



# 9TH ANNUAL KEIKI TILAPIA FISHING TOURNAMENT

**Date:** Saturday, March 24, 2018

**Time:** 7:30 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. (Check-In Opens at 6:45 a.m.)

**Place:** Ka'anapali Golf Courses (KGC) Pond, 2290 Ka'anapali Parkway, Lahaina

**Parking:** Free event parking is available on the KGC driving range. Please follow the applicable signs that will be posted near the KGC entrance.

## TOURNAMENT RULES

- This is a “catch and release” event for tilapias.
- The tournament will begin promptly at 7:30 a.m. and end at 9:00 a.m., marked by the sound of a horn.
- Participants will have a total of 1½ hours to fish and qualify for prizes.
- Fishing will take place on two (2) sides of the designated KGC pond, marked by boundary markers.
- Fish must be pole-caught in the KGC pond
- Participants must provide their own gear to include: pole, hook, line, sinker, swivel, lead, bait, bucket, and pump.
- Straight Poles **ONLY** (NO POLES WITH REELS).
- Maximum length of pole and line is 12 feet. Poles will be measured to ensure it does not exceed height limit.
- No nets will be used to catch fish or aid in the catching of fish.
- No diving in the pond to catch fish.
- No grabbing the fish out of the pond.
- Fish will be measured by weight and must be alive at weigh-in to qualify for a prize. No mutilated tilapia will be counted.
- Prizes (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place) will be given in the Biggest Fish category for each age division (Ages 2-5, 6-12, 13-18).
- In the event of a tie, weigh-in time will determine the winner.
- Must be present to win.
- Judges' decisions are final.
- After fish is weighed, it will be released back to the pond by a tournament official.
- For safety reasons, fishing on the bridge is not allowed.
- Keiki participants must wear covered footwear at all times.
- Keiki participants must have adult supervision at all times.
- Adults may **ONLY** assist keiki with prepping the pole (hook, bait), bringing the fish in after it's been hooked, and/or removing the fish from its hook.



Refreshments will be sold at the event with proceeds benefiting Maui United Way. However, due to sanitary reasons, you are advised not to eat/drink while handling fish.

This is a non-alcoholic and non-smoking event. Please be considerate of those around you.

As a reminder, no tents, motorized vehicles/carts or pets will be allowed on the golf course. Please use proper golf course etiquette at all times.
